Tiny Pantry Instructions



Lay out the back panel on a flat surface. Using a drill, screw the side panels in place. For a faster and easier process, pre-paint the panels and pre-drill all holes.



Attach the bottom of the pantry, the shelf support and the shelf.



Screw down the roof, making sure you have even overlap in the front and the back.



For the door, first drill all the holes for the plexiglass windowpane. Then, use a hand screwdriver and caulk to attach the plexiglass and prevent cracking.



Add the hinges to the inside of the door and then connect the hinges to the pantry frame.



Attach shingles to the roof using roofing nails. For the final layer, use caulk to attach.



Utilize a hook-and-eye to keep the door closed.



Drill the attachment panel onto the bottom of the pantry. Hammer a stake into the ground at your desired location and attach to the bottom panel.
